

## TEINTURIER SAPERAVI 2023

Our estate Saperavi is sourced from plantings rooted deep in the shale slopes that define our region. Standing Stone Vineyards first planted a quarter acre of the Georgian varietal in 1994, and have continued to add acreage to the site over the subsequent decades. Saperavi is a teinturier varietal unique for having pigmented pulp. This wine displays black and red fruit notes on the palate and finishes with structural acidity and fine tannins.


